Woodlands Hospice is an independent charity situated in the grounds of University Hospital Aintree and serves a population of 330,000 in South Sefton, North Liverpool and Knowsley.

The Hospice provides **Specialist Palliative care** for people living with life-threatening illness, taking into account their physical, psychological, social and spiritual needs. Care is provided by a multi-professional clinical team and includes support for families and carers both individually and via the Carers' support group.
