

Christmas Pudding Crochet Pattern



You will need:	Stitch Markers
Double-knit wool (White/Brown/Green/Red)	Scissors
Needles UK Size 11 (3mm)	Yarn Needle
Needles UK Size 7 (4.5mm)	Chocolate Orange (for size fit)

1. Round 1: With white make a Magic Ring and Sc 6 into the centre (6)

R2: ScInc in each stitch (12)

R3: *ScInc, Sc* X6 (18)

R4: *ScInc, Sc in next 2 stitches* X6 (24)

R5: *ScInc, Sc in next 3 stitches* X6 (30)

R6: *ScInc, Sc in next 4 stitches* X6 (36)

R7 - 10: Sc x36

R11: Sc x36 then slip stitch in the front loop only of the next stitch

R12 (White): *Skip 1 stitch, 5 Double Crochet into the same stitch front loop only (ShellFLO), Skip 1 stitch, slip stitch front loop only* Repeat X9 SS to join (9 ShellFLO) fasten off white.

Join brown to any stitch from R11 in back loop only.

R12 (Brown): Sc BLO x36 (36)

R13 - 16: Sc x36 (36)

R17: *Sc2tog, sc in next 7 stitches* x4 (32)

R18: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 stitches* x4 (28)

R19: *Sc2tog, Sc in next 5 stitches* x5 (24) SS, fasten off and weave in ends

For the leaves and berries we recommend this crochet pattern

Berries and Leaves

Sew the leaves and berries to the top of your pudding!

18. Insert chocolate orange and check it doesn't drop out when held by head. Add extra stitches to tighten if required.

Abbreviations:

Sc - Single Crochet

ScInc - Single Crochet Increase, Sc two in the same stitch

FLO - Front Loop only

BLO - Back Loop Only

SS - Slip Stitch

ShellFLO - 5 Double Crochet in the same stitch, front loop only

Sc2tog - single crochet 2 stitches together
