

Our Ted Knitting Pattern

You will need:

Double-knit wool (Main/Trouser/Jumper)

Needles UK Size 10 (3.25mm)



1. Using main colour, cast on 10 stitches and knit 10 rows. (Garter stitch)

2. Change to trouser colour and knit 30 rows.

3. Knit second leg the same.

4. Knit across all 20 stitches for 16 rows.

5. Change to jumper colour and knit 24 rows.

6. Change to main colour for head and stocking stitch 5.5 inches.

7. Change to jumper colour and continue knitting the teddy in reverse order.

8. Cast off at end of each foot.

9. Stitch down sides of head.

10. Using jumper colour, pick up 8 stitches at each side of neck (i.e each side of the head seam) and knit 20 rows to form arm.

11. Change to main colour and knit 10 rows. Cast off

12. Repeat on the other side for the second arm.

13. Sew up teddy leaving an opening in the crotch to allow for stuffing.

*Please stuff teddy with Kapok or similar clean material but **NOT** foam rubber. (Pillows are sometimes sold quite cheaply but please check the filling.)

14. Use small running stitches around the neck and draw up to shape the head. (Do not wind wool around the neck as small fingers may get caught).

15. Sew diagonally across the top corners to form ears.

16. Stitch a happy face on teddy.

Please ensure that all ends are fastened securely

Scarf - Cast on 75 stitches. Knit 4 rows. Cast off.

Bag - Made from fabric, finished size 10 X 13 inches with double seams to prevent fraying and a double hem at the top to thread a 'draw string' so that the bag can be closed.
